Eligibility

Applicant Eligibility

- Must be a for-profit business or non-profit organization
- Must have been affected by COVID-19
- Small businesses with up to 25 employees
- Must be located within Orange County's Fourth District
- Small businesses and non-profits who received prior federal and state disaster funding are eligible

Businesses engaging in the sale of CBD, Marijuana, gambling, and adult entertainment strip clubs are not eligible.



Grant Selection

Applicants that meet the criteria will be randomly selected based on the population share of each city and unincorporated areas within the district.

Keeping It Local

Applicants are encouraged to make a reasonable effort to utilize grant funding to procure services and products locally.

Use of Funding

Businesses and non-profits can request up to \$10,000 in funding for use on the following eligible expenses:

Rent, payroll (as long as PPP funding was not received or has been exhausted) utilities, insurance, accounts payable, personal protective equipment (PPE), inventory, office supplies, professional services (e.g. janitorial, accounting, etc.)
