- Transport your firearms **UNLOADED** in a bag, box or case.
- Keep firearms in the trunk of your vehicle.
- Remain in your vehicle at all times.
- **DO NOT TOUCH ANY WEAPONS.**
- An officer will remove the gun from the vehicle.
- If the trunk or rear hatch can not be opened remotely by the driver, the driver will hand the officer the key.
- The drive-up event is limited to three firearms per person.
- No walk-ups allowed.
- No BB, pellet, 3D printed or Homemade guns will be accepted.
