

Construction Alert



Caspers Wilderness Park: Metal Pipe Replacement for Stormwater Drainage, Road Closure Needed



OC Public Works, in collaboration with OC Parks, will be replacing a stormwater pipe at Caspers Park Road to enhance water flow and reduce the risk of flooding within an area of Caspers Wilderness Park. A temporary road closure will be needed, as identified by the details below.

WHAT

Crews will:

- Replace six corrugated metal pipes with corrugated steel pipes
- Replace “rip rap” sections (large rocks used for flood protection), and;
- Repave/restripe roadway section in the project area

Road Closure: The section of Caspers Park Road that crosses along the ravine within the park will be closed during project construction.

Campgrounds will also be closed through July and August.

Park users may experience minimal construction noise and dust in areas adjacent to the project location.

Anticipated Construction Duration

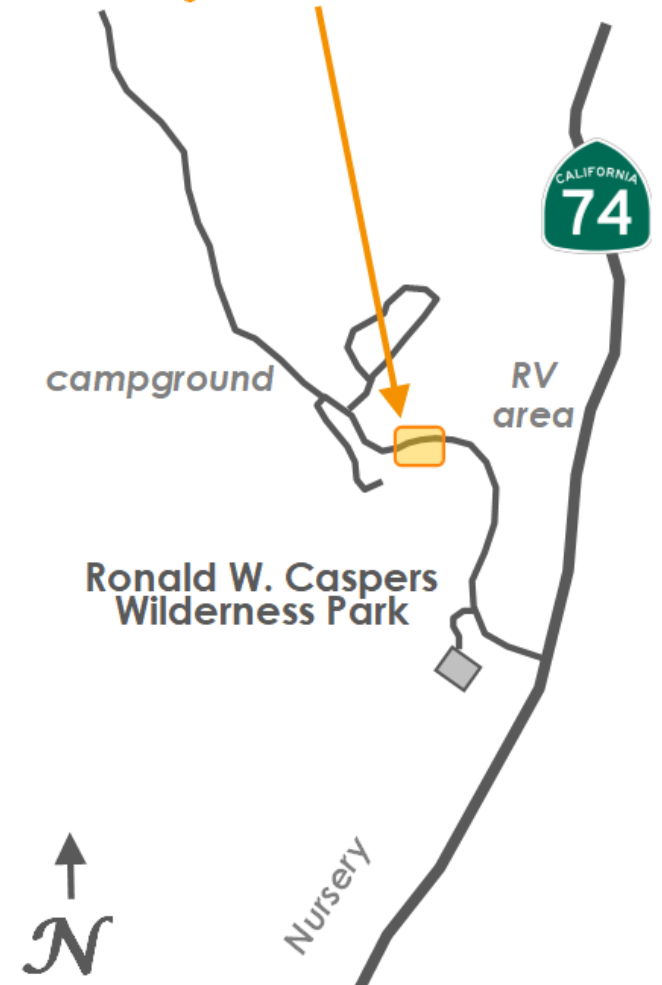
July 7 through mid-August 2020
