



## Oso Parkway Bridge Project

### Project Update: May 29, 2020

### All Lanes on Oso Parkway Now Open!

Construction activities, including new connection below the bridge, will continue until October 2020.

#### **i** WHAT

Westbound and eastbound lanes along Oso Parkway have reopened to their full configuration.

**NOTE: Temporary lane closures** will be needed at times to install traffic detection loops along Oso Parkway, install permanent striping and relocate traffic signals at each end of the project area.

#### **Other Remaining Construction Activities:**

Construction activities through overall completion in October 2020 include:

- Final preparations of SR-241 and Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Complete overhead signs along SR-241 ramps
- Level utility manhole covers with road surface
- Complete grading slopes along SR-241 and Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Complete concrete drainage ditch along Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Relocate utility service meter cabinet and traffic signal controller
- Complete miscellaneous electrical work

7 am—3 pm, as needed to complete various construction activities

**Overall Project Completion:**

October 2020
